Education Leadership (EDLD) provides a Principal Certification Program at A&M-Texarkana offering 1) a 30-hour Master's Degree in Education Leadership, or 2) an 18-hour Principal Certification-Only program with an ongoing (3-semester) principal practicum lab. Both programs provide students with the necessary skills to become effective school administrators within today's educational climate. Courses are delivered fully online and are supported with virtual class meetings. The program emphasizes quality interactions between the instructor and student. - 7. Letter of support from current principal (form letter provided by coordinator)
